Below are some ideas of goods and equipment that you may want to have available for your Clothes Closet. Note that many, but not all, of the items are things that church members and the community could donate from their own closets and homes. We recommend establishing a permanent donation site at your church for this purpose.

- Storage shelves to keep the clothes clean and organized
- Storage bins to organize smaller items such as socks and underwear
- Hangers
- Hanging racks or bars
- Easy-to-read labels/signs for organization and customer ease (multilingual if applicable)
- Curtains for a dressing room
